Before starting the book:

- Explore different covers explain different editions. What does each one tell us about the story? Predictions. Gradual reveal of the different ones. Return to them at the end and decide which one was the best representation of the book.
- Start with timeline of CS Lewis' life and understanding how this fits chronologically with other events, people and periods of time children have studied:
